Dave Fairlamb of Natural Links enthralled us with his talk 'Wight Wildlife through the Seasons' at Café Botanique last autumn. We now invite you to join Dave on a Nature Walk (2 miles) along the lower slopes and woodland of Tennyson Down and onto the downland ridge and heath of West High Down, returning via the southern slopes overlooking the towering white chalk cliffs.

Early autumn is a wonderful time in the natural world, many resident bird species are gathering in flocks, while others are beginning their migration south, passing over the Island. Butterflies, dragonflies and damselflies are still on the wing and downland wildflowers provide early autumn colour. Binoculars recommended.
